

Project Instructions

Tissue Jar Candle Holder

Supplies:

- Clean jar
- Tissue paper
- Paint brush
- Small bowl
- School glue
- Water

1. Rip some colorful tissue into small (but not tiny) pieces. Feel free to cut some pieces of tissue into fun shapes like snowflakes, faces, flowers, letters, etc.
2. In the bowl, add about two TBSP of school glue.
3. Slowly add water and stir with your paint brush until the consistency is that of a tempura paint.
4. Use your paint brush and apply the glue/paint to outside of the jar in a small section, then lay a piece of tissue onto the glue/paint.
5. Repeat this process all around the outside of the jar.
6. Reserve your special tissue shapes and apply them last, over the top of the other tissue.
7. Let the jar dry completely.
8. Embellish with ribbon if you'd like.
9. Place a small votive or tea light in the bottom of the jar and enjoy!
