## Instructions

### “Make A Kid Command Canvas Bag”

#### Supplies Needed:

- Canvas bag (can be purchased inexpensively from a craft supply store)
- Iron-on transfer paper (can be purchased at office supply or discount stores)
- Iron
- Flat surface

#### Step By Step:

1. Preheat your iron.

Note – Please follow the instructions included with your iron-on transfer paper.

2. Click on the Kid Command image link on this newsletter page.
3. Use your Inkjet printer to print your Kid Command image onto your transfer paper.
4. Cut out your image.
5. Put your canvas bag on a flat surface.
6. Place transfer paper – image side down – onto your canvas bag.
7. Iron the image onto the canvas bag.

Again – Be sure to follow the instructions with your iron-on transfer paper.

8. Allow the bag to cool completely.
9. Peel the iron-on paper away and enjoy your cool new Kid Command grocery sack!
